Hunter Education in Texas

Every hunter (including out-of-state hunters) born on or after Sept. 2, 1971, must successfully complete a Hunter Education Training Course. Minimum age of certification is 9 years. Hunter Education is a movement to improve sport hunting. The main goal of hunter education is to produce **SAFE, RESPONSIBLE, KNOWLEDGEABLE** and **INVOLVED** hunters. Courses give beginning hunters a place to start, denying them the temptation to learn by "trial-and-error". Hunter education refreshed veteran hunters and provides them with a tool to pass on proper information and values of hunting.

If you were born on or after Sept. 2, 1971, and you are:

- under 9 years of age, **you must be accompanied***.
- Age 9 through 16, you **must successfully complete a hunter education course, or be accompanied***.
- age 17 and over, you **must successfully complete a hunter education course; or purchase "Hunter Education Deferral", and you must be accompanied***.

***Accompanied means:** By a person who is at least 17, who is licensed to hunt in Texas, who has passed hunter education or is exempt (born before Sept. 2, 1971), and you must be within normal voice control. Proof of certification or deferral is required to be on your person while hunting.

Note: Certification is not required to purchase a hunting license.

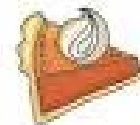
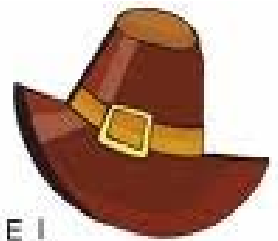
