District 12 Round UP

The 2015 District 12 4-H Roundup will be held on Saturday, May 2, 2015 at Texas A&M University – Kingsville located at 955 University Blvd. in Kingsville, Texas. Registration for all Roundup events will be online through 4-H CONNECT and will require individual registration, along with certification at the county and district levels. The registration fee will be \$15.00 per person per contest. 4-H members can register for up to 2 contests. Individual online registration opens Tuesday, March 31st through the deadline of Tuesday, April 21st. Check-in on the day of Roundup will begin at 9:00 a.m. (Kleberg Ag Hallway), participant/judges orientation will follow at 9:30 a.m. (Kleberg Ag Auditorium), and the contests will begin at 10:00 a.m. For any questions please contact the Duval Extension Office at 361-256-4591. Below are the different Contest events to choose from,

Selecting a contest:

- To participate in 1 (one) contest, a 4-H member may select a contest from either Group A or Group B.
- To participate in 2 (two) contests, a 4-H member may select only 1 contest from Group A and only 1 contest from Group B. There may be judging delays for all 4-H events as a result of 4-H'ers entering contests from both groups, so expect that. Also, it is possible that a 4-H member may not be able to participate in the other contest if the conflicts negatively impact other contestants.
